Hello Residents,

Recent coyote sightings have been reported within the Bernardo Heights community. Coyotes are native wildlife and may occasionally travel through residential neighborhoods.

Residents are encouraged to use caution, particularly when walking small pets or allowing pets outdoors. Please:

- Keep pets leashed and supervised.
- Do not leave pet food outdoors.
- Secure trash and other potential food sources.
- Never intentionally feed coyotes or other wildlife.

If a coyote approaches, keep children and pets close, make noise, and give the animal plenty of space and an unobstructed path to leave the area.

Routine coyote sightings may be reported through the California Department of Fish and Wildlife’s Wildlife Incident Reporting System. If a coyote is acting aggressively or poses an immediate threat, contact the appropriate animal-control agency or call 911 in an emergency.
